Bruno Engelmeier (Goalkeeper) One of the stars of the team is the 26-year-old employee of Vienna Corporation. He has played for Austria 14 times and been an international reserve 18 times. He has played three times against the redoubtable Hungarians and has also met Italy, Switzerland, Czechoslovakia and Germany. He was recently transferred to F.C. Wien from another Austrian club.

Rudolf Oslansky (right-back). (22), a plumber and electrician, he has played five times for the Austrian Junior team and was twice reserve for the Austrian "B" team. Quick and hard tackling he is regarded by the Austrians as having a great future in football.

Frederick Kotter (left-back). Is the "father" of the team at 33. He was born in Czechoslovakia, but has lived in Vienna for the past five years. A cool defender.

J. Bohme (right-half). In his early 20's, a merchant by occupation, is a constructive player who has recently joined F.C. Wien.

Karl Tepy (centre-half). (28) is a locksmith. He has played in Austrian regional teams.

Robert Kaffka (left-half). (23) is a member of the well-known Austrian team Rapide and is guesting with F.C. Wien for this tour.

Frederick Steindl (outside-right). Is a speedy winger with many goals to his credit. By trade he is a mechanic.

Adalbert Bohm (inside-right). (27), is the "brain" of the attack. He has played for Austria and has reached peak with F.C. Wien.

Karl Burgstaller (centre-forward). (20), is the "mouthpiece" of the side, speaking English well. He is studying to be a veterinary student in Vienna. He, too, is guesting with the tourists from Rapide.

Anton Kasamas (inside-left). (20), played for the Austrian Youth team against Switzerland. He is an automobile mechanic.

Josef Hammerl (outside-left). (22), another international, is the tallest of the side. He is very fast and is another who is regarded as having a great future. He is a mechanic by trade.

TERRAS' TOPICS

TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 16th, 1954

Welcome tonight to our friends ADMIRA F.C. from Vienna, Austria. We feel sure all fans here tonight will give them a rousing welcome and as is always the case in these floodlit matches, every encouragement for the fine arts of the game.

As a number of you spectators will know, our opponents were spectators at Saturday's match against Yeovil and whilst we must congratulate our team on their splendid victory, certainly the most clear-cut over our neighbours from Yeovil since our re-entry into the Southern League, it is to be regretted that the game was marred by one or two unpleasant incidents resulting in Andy Easton getting "marching orders."

It was rather a question of feelings outrunning common-sense and it is hoped that our Viennese friends who saw the match on Saturday, will not get a false impression. Let me assure them that it is not often that such things are seen on the "Rec." and perhaps if more strict control had been kept "in the middle," this could have been stamped out much earlier.

But there it is, let us put the past behind us and look forward to a real good evening's entertainment and may be we shall be able to get some understanding of the continental conception of football as it should be played.

It is often said that the continentals are inclined to over-elaborate and lack punch, well we can see for ourselves tonight.

If youth is anything to contend with, our visitors certainly should have the advantage in this side of the game. The average age of all the players who have come to Weymouth, is under twenty-four years.

So far on this tour they have played Watford, which they lost by a single goal, and Swindon where they lost by the odd goal. But that should make tonight's match all the more interesting, as one so often hears comparisons drawn between the Southern League and the Third Division. Swindon and Watford are good average League sides. Let us see if we can improve on what those teams managed to accomplish.

Whatever the result of the match this evening, we trust that our friends have really enjoyed their stay at Weymouth and let us hope that this first visit of a continental side to Weymouth will not be the last and that they will take back with them to Austria, a feeling of Good Will and Fellowship and that this will pave the way either for their return visit, or may be an inducement to other continental teams to try their skill in Weymouth.

So let's look forward to an enjoyable game, naturally hoping that we shall be able to win and still retain the friendship of our visitors.

Wir geben ein herzliches Willkommen heute Abend zu unseren Freunden, Wien F.C., Osterreich.


